

## HOW TO ORDER A "GRAVE SPECIFIC" WREATH FROM WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA




## On the WAA Home Page for our Committee, click the SPONSOR WREATHS button again.

(If you click the "Volunteer Button" next to it, you'll be redirected back to the Support Committee's website page for the next WAA event. There, you can download our Participation / Sign-Up Form if you wish to Volunteer and place our general – sponsored wreaths, the regular donated wreaths, which will be placed in 2 or 3 sections of Calverton, as determined by the Support Committee. Those sections are rotated, year to year to give each section "a chance" to be decorated. Wreaths Across America does NOT supply wreaths to cover the entire Cemetery.)




## On the next screen, click the area on the bottom that states "Grave Specific."

The only other choice you have, on the top half of this screen, is to "Sponsor" or Donate a wreath that the volunteers will place in certain sections on Wreaths Across America Day. This is where families, friends and companies can choose to donate "to the cause." Wreaths ordered here are NOT for personal use. Also, the number of wreaths you order may not equal the number of wreaths that you may pick up from the Committee on WAA Day. We need to provide ALL Donated wreaths to ALL volunteers that come out that day.



- 1. Tell us whether YOU will be picking up your wreath from our Committee on WAA Day in December OR whether you want one of our Volunteers to do it for you. (This is great if you live out of the area and can't get here.)
- 2. Enter your Loved One's First and Last Names, NOT your Name.
- 3. Identify whether your Loved One was in the U.S. Military OR is a Spouse / Family Member.

Then, continue to SCROLL DOWN on this screen.




If one of our Volunteers is placing your wreath, we NEED as much information as you can give us. It will greatly assist us in finding your Loved One's grave site. Our "Find A Grave" link, located on the Support Committee's website Home Page, will provide a great deal of information, including a section number and gravesite number. It is the same VA database that is used at the Cemetery's Administration Building.

Continue to Scroll Down on this screen.

The next areas have some options that you MUST select from in order to continue. Most people will select "No Thanks" in these two areas.


Click "ADD TO CART." If you missed something on this page, it will refer you back to the area where you forgot to select something. You'll then see the next "pop-up" box.



IF you have more than one person that you wish to get a grave site wreath for, CLICK "Add another of this item" and enter the next person's Name, Section Number, Gravesite Number, etc. You HAVE TO do this so that each Grave Specific wreath has the correct Name associated with it. Our Committee won't know this information until you inform us this way. IF you order 5 Grave Specific Wreaths, then we need 5 Names to go with that order.

## Then CLICK on "PROCEED TO CHECKOUT."

You should NOT order 5 general sponsored wreaths (the donated kind) to accomplish your task. We won't have your loved one's names and you won't get your wreaths on WAA Day.




You can REVIEW the items in your cart to make sure that you ordered them correctly.

Remember, the "Wreath Sponsorship" wreath is a <u>Donation</u> to the overall count of wreaths that our Volunteers will place in designated sections. These are NOT for personal use.

"Grave Specific" wreaths ARE for your personal use. If you entered more than 1 loved one's name to get a gravesite wreath, the quantity number should match your final count.

Then CLICK on "START CHECKOUT."



You'll need a valid Email address to enter. The Order Summary window is a final "double check" for you. Once you provide your Billing and Payment information and click "PLACE ORDER", the Support Committee cannot change anything for you.

For example, if you order a "Wreath Sponsorship" wreath and now want it for a loved one's gravesite, we will NOT be able to change or adjust this to a "Grave Specific" wreath for you, despite the fact that they are both the same price.

A Specific Name is required for each Grave Specific Wreath!
